- **All gifts and bonuses given or paid for/by San Jose Water for any of the ten highest paid employees and the board of directors for the most recent three year period.**

Since some of the documents listed above may be more readily available then others please provide the documents that are available as soon as possible without waiting to provide access to all documents. I promise to pay reasonable search and duplication fees in connection with this request. However, If you estimate that the total fee will exceed \$100, please notify me so I may authorize the expenditure of a greater amount.
