INFORMATION WANTED

The Los Angeles Police Department is seeking the public's assistance in locating a vacant residence in the Northridge, Canoga Park or Winnetka area that might have been used during the kidnap of a 10-year old from her Northridge home on March 27, 2013.

The residence is described as a single story structure with an attached garage on the right side as you face it. The garage has a metal roll-up door. There is a small bathroom window from which you can view the street on the left, front side of the residence. There are wooden entry gates on both sides of the house.

The residence is empty of furniture and has a mixture of wood, carpet and tile floors. There is a sliding door in the back. A white for sale sign with blue lettering was seen in the garage.

The bathroom has a built-in bathtub with a mosaic pattern of dark brown, tan, black and white tiles on the walls surrounding it. There is a showerhead without a curtain or shower door. The bathroom has two mirrors that can be removed from the mountings above the double sinks. On the night of the incident, the victim was able to see police cars and hear a helicopter from the bathroom window. She stated the helicopter was not directly overhead.
